**PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES**

July 9, 2013

**Meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm.**

**A quorum was met with four commissioners present however it was waived and no official actions of voting took place due to not providing proper notice of the meeting to constituents.**

- Welcome and greetings were made by Chairperson Kathy Henderson.
- **Treasurer report read by Treasurer India Henderson**
  - Commission was allotted \$27,203.88 from the District Government.
  - One check was written for \$25.00 for Security Fund.
  - Received an addition allotment of \$4082.66 from DC government on 5/23.
  - Current account balance is \$31,261.54.
- Lt. Wright gave PSA report and took questions from Commissioners and citizens.
  - 5<sup>th</sup> District tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> place in reduction of crime.
  - Update on Michael Kingsbury case
  - Commissioner Kathy Henderson asked the appropriate protocol for community support in cases of missing persons – Question was answered by both Lt. Wright and Cpt. Wright.

- KIPP DC presentation followed by questions from Commissioners and citizens.
  - Residents want to meet with construction team to discuss the negative impact on the community.
  - Commissioner Lewis request they provide outreach in the Ivy City and neighboring communities to ensure local students have the opportunity to enroll.
- **Announcements/Citizen concerns were discussed.**
  - Announcement of National Night Out event for Commission
  - Car barn/Trolley question and Commission's position.
