NE for 151 patients; 23 are Ward 5 residents; hours of operation are 6 am-10 pm; asking for a 10-year lease; will provide free kidney screenings; new location must be within a mile of the old location, which is near Union Station; will hire union contractors and implement a landscaping plan in front of location

5. Gallaudet University Presentation: Chris Collins and Hansel Bauman

Going to Zoning Commission for an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan;; seeking to amend the plan to update their campus dorms; the building is 39 feet tall instead of 55; presented to ANC 5D01 community on 10-21-14; community and ANC for 5D01 support the plan; building will be LEED silver
