



TO ESTABLISH ANC 5D COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION SAFETY

Whereas, Safe and effective transportation of all modes is a significant priority for local government and for the residents and businesses of ANC 5D. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT), in coordination with other agencies, maintains the transportation system while protecting and improving the use of public space in the District. ANC 5D lacks a structured method to effectively address transportation safety.

Resolved, ANC 5D hereby establishes a Transportation Safety Committee, comprised of interested ANC 5D Commissioners and selected community residents, to promote a safe and effective transportation plan and system for residents and visitors of ANC 5D; and be it further

Resolved, ANC 5D designates one ANC 5D Commissioner and one community resident as the Co-Chairs of the Committee; Both Co-Chairs and members serve at the pleasure of the ANC, with tenure start and end dates determined by ANC voting action; and be it further

Resolved, That the Transportation Safety Committee shall be charged with meeting on a monthly basis, as needed, to review all ANC 5D applications and proposals relating to transportation, parking and other similar topics; additionally the committee will serve as a forum for discussing matters related to traffic safety, pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure and safety, public transit, public parking, and matters before the DC Council related to transportation.

This resolution presented by Commissioner Burkett came before ANC 5D at a duly noticed public meeting on June 11, 2019. ANC 5D is composed of 7 Commissioners such that 4 Commissioners constitute a quorum. With [5] Commissioners present, ANC5D voted [5] (Yea) [0] (Nay) [0] (Abstain).
